

1. Take to the streets and make your opposition public. Thousands of people have already taken to the streets in dozens of cities across the U.S. and worldwide to protest Israel's attacks on the Gaza Strip. Check our website for regular updates on upcoming events in the Houston area.

2. Educate and organize people in your community. Attend public events and pass out information on Israel's atrocities in Gaza and to collect signatures to end U.S. military aid to Israel.

3. Contact your elected representatives and set up emergency meetings with your Members of Congress. Demand from the President, your Representative, and Senators an unconditional, immediate cease-fire; full humanitarian access to Gaza and a lifting of Israel's siege; and accountability for Israel's misuse of U.S. weapons to kill Palestinian civilians.
